

HALCYON'S ENTRY POLICY

Each horse show has a closing date for entries specified on the front cover of the prize list. Entries received on or before that date are considered a "pre-entry". After that date and up to noon on the Thursday before each show, entries are accepted and are considered to be a "late entry" and will be subject to a \$15 late fee. From that point on, entries are considered to be post entries and will be charged a \$25 post entry fee. There is no reason for any exhibitor to subject themselves to these fees, as there is absolutely no fee to scratch. We only request the courtesy of a phone call or e-mail by notifying us of your scratch.

Pre-entries must have all USEF numbers for the horse, owner, rider and trainer in order to be processed. Incomplete entries will be charged the \$15 late fee regardless of their date of receipt.

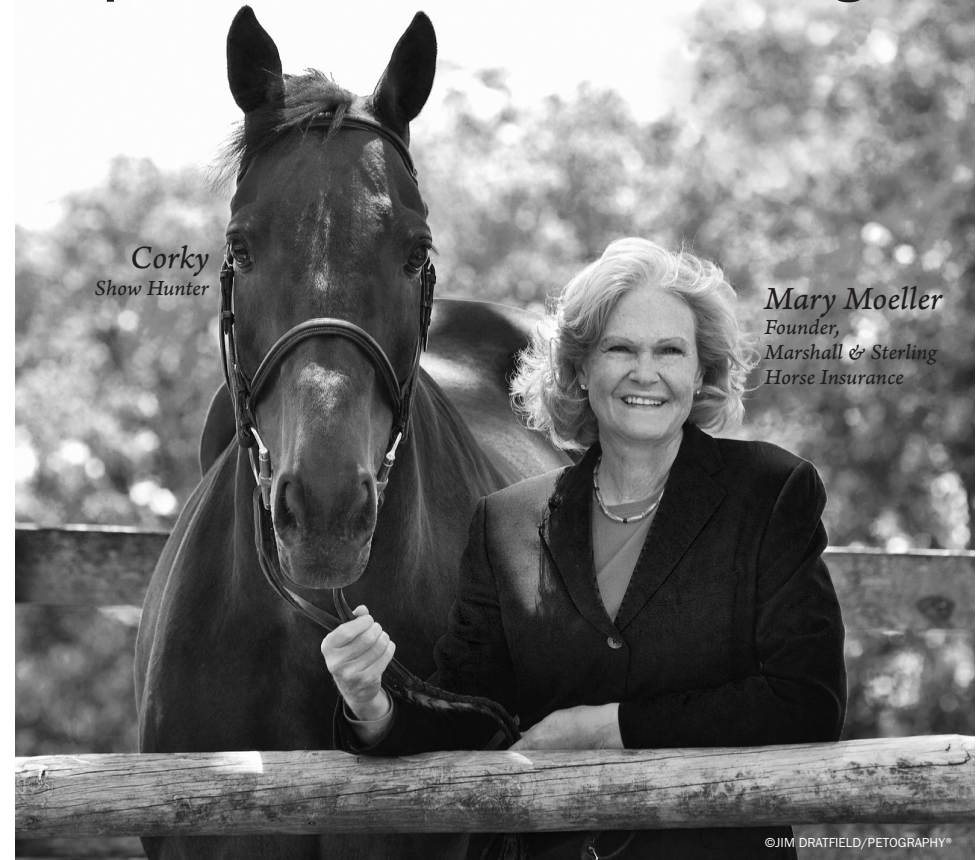

LEADLINE SECTION

Ribbons to all. Open to children who have not reached their 7th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may not compete in any other classes except Walk-Trot-Equitation or Walk-Trot Pleasure. To be judged on manners and suitability of pony to rider-50%, and horsemanship of rider-50%. May be asked to trot.

Fence height not to exceed 18". Children riding in this section are not eligible for any hunter or jumper classes or any equitation classes where fences are 2" or higher at the same show. Riders may show in pleasure and Short-Stirrup Hunter.

OPEN PLEASURE HORSE AND PONY DIVISION

Open to horses and ponies. A horse or pony entering a hunter or jumper class may not enter the pleasure division at the same show. Exception: Horse or ponies competing in the Pre-Children's and/or Pre-Adult Hunters and/or Modified Hunters are eligible but must be ridden by a different rider. The division must be split if there are at least six horses and six ponies entered.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be judged in accordance therewith.
2. Please mail or fax your pre-entry as soon as possible. There is no fee to scratch. Please, NO phone entries.
3. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners unless otherwise specified.
4. Halcyon Farm, Ltd., the Committee or property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
5. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule Book shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.
6. All fees must be paid and entry completed before numbers can be issued. Membership cards and measurement cards (where applicable) must be presented.
7. The committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes or schooling deemed necessary.
8. The management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry, or to return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to Judges or officials on the part of the owner, rider, trainer or groom shall disqualify the entry and the owner shall forfeit entry and other fees.
9. All riders must wear proper attire including proper headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
10. Prize money and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the section, at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
11. NO DOGS ALLOWED.
12. It is a condition of entry that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted.
13. Rotating jump orders will be used for all classes over fences.
14. Trophy or prize money and 8 ribbons will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise noted.
15. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes within USEF rules. Classes with four or more entries can not be cancelled.
16. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by and adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
17. Should the veterinarian on call be needed to complete permanent measurements of horses and ponies, the appointed time will be 9:00 AM. ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEASUREMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE THROUGH SHOW MANAGEMENT. "Day" measurements can be accommodated throughout the show day.

Course will be the second hunter course. Rider must state to the in-gate supervisor if they are doing a warm up round prior to entering the ring. If two rings are being utilized, there will be separately judged warm ups.

Open to all horses and ponies. To be judged on performance and soundness. Fences 2'3" or 2'9".
